



Montgomery County Lead and Healthy Homes Program

This program is being organized by Montgomery County Health and Human Services and ACLAMO to prevent childhood lead poisoning and to promote lead-free, healthy housing. **Only available to those living in the borough of Pottstown and Lansdale.**

- Houses built before 1978 may have lead-based paint
- Children under 6 are especially vulnerable to lead poisoning
- Lead poisoning can cause severe damage to the brain and body

Qualifications:

- Own or rent a property in Pottstown or Lansdale
- Unit where a child under six resides or regularly visits OR where a pregnant woman resides
- Home built before 1978
- Household income below 80% of the Area Median Income (see chart)
